

## One Flew South

At one of the world's busiest airports the interior of its first upscale restaurant is all about modern Southern regionalism: Georgia granite, a pine forest mural, white tables and a wooden bar create a simple, clean and bright atmosphere.

Todd Richards and Duane Nutter have created a matching menu they call "Southernational – cuisine inspired by world travels". It is a playful relationship between Southern classics and Asian influences. While the cuisine is globally influenced, the products

used in the kitchen come from regional farmers and purveyors. In addition, there is a great cocktail and spirits menu as well as a sushi bar with an extra sushi menu.

One could pay a visit here simply for some sushi or sashimi and a glass or two of really good Junmai sake before winging off to Japan or Korea. For those with a bigger appetite we recommend the barbecue scallops and roasted pork belly with black-eyed pea and arugula salad, parsnip puree and onion marmalade followed by a plate of Sweet Grass Dairy cheeses from Thomasville, Georgia.
