One Flew South, Atlanta, GA

What To Order: Pulled Duck Sandwich.

One Flew South is a unicorn among restaurants: It makes me want to spend *more* time in the Atlanta airport. Whenever I have a layover, I make a beeline to Concourse E, snag a seat at the bar, and order the Pulled Duck Sandwich. Within the layers of duck confit, fig-and-peanut relish, scallions, and slaw, the fat and spice dance with a medley of textures. It's the perfect sandwich. And it's in an *airport*.
